THE SUBSTITUTE

1 Peter 3:18

The era in which Peter wrote was marked by growing persecution and collective suffering. Most likely penned during the reign of Nero (AD 54-68), we can target AD 64-65 as the period of time when 1 Peter was written. In a time when Caesar was deified and sacrifices to false gods were occurring, Christians faced tremendous opposition due to their exclusive allegiance to Jesus Christ.

In 1 Peter 3:18, Peter writes of the substitutionary work of Jesus Christ. In a culture of false spirituality, substitutes for the true Sovereign God of the universe were commonplace. In contrast, Peter writes of the true substitute, Jesus Christ, who died in our place. As we prepare to partake of the communion elements, we will focus upon Jesus Christ and his work on our behalf.
