A VERY STRATEGIC SETTING Acts 18:1-17

As the Apostle Paul left Athens for Corinth, he headed in the direction of Athens' chief rival. Corinth was the capital of the region in Greece known as Achaia. Having long since surpassed Athens in influence, Corinth was known as a worldwide hub of commerce. Strategically located on the north-south, east-west intersection for commerce, Corinth was known as "the bridge of the sea", which can be understood when we examine the map.

Acts 18:1-17 describes the Apostle Paul's time in Corinth, and his work of establishing a church in the region. Having reached this important city around the fall of A.D. 51, the Apostle befriended Aquilla and Priscilla, fellow Jews who had become followers of Jesus Christ. With Silas and Timothy arriving from Macedonia, a powerful ministry team was established to penetrate that very strategic setting with the gospel of Jesus Christ. Let's explore these verses together.
