GOD & GOVERNMENT

Romans 13:1-7

In Philippians 3:20, the Apostle Paul wrote “But *our citizenship* is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ.” From Scripture, it becomes clear that Christians possess dual citizenship. There is an uppercase citizenship, associated with heaven, and a lowercase citizenship, associated with earth. During our earthly stay, both citizenships operate simultaneously.

As we have noted in our Acts Series, our church citizenship is understood in relation to uppercase authority (God) and lowercase authority (government). When the lowercase replaces the uppercase, government replaces God among the citizens, resulting in the idolatry of government. When God remains in the upper case and government is left in the lower case, the Scriptural teachings on dual citizenship equips believers to be highly effective in impacting lives for Jesus Christ. Let's ponder those thoughts, as we prepare ourselves for the upcoming elections.
