#### AFTER THE UPROAR CEASED

Acts 20:1-16

The book of Acts describes three significant journeys of the Apostle Paul. The first journey is chronicled in 13:1—14:28. The second journey is found in 15:36—18:22. The third journey is recounted in 18:23—21:16. Each journey is marked by the providential care provided by God as the Apostle sought to multiply committed followers of Jesus Christ.

In Acts 20:1-16, the writer Luke describes the continuous changes to Paul's itinerary brought about by life's circumstances. In Proverbs 16:9 we are told the heart of man plans his way, but the LORD establishes his steps. Has God changed the itinerary of your life? It is possible that you have possessed plans, dreams, and goals that required adjustments, because God changed your itinerary? If this has been your life experience, reflect upon those verses, and ponder how the insights derived from this passage equip you to effectively live for God's will, for God's glory.
