THE HEAVENS DECLARE

Psalm 19:1-14

Psalm 19 gives us opportunity to reflect upon two significant witnesses to God's glory. Verses 1-6 give witness to God's glory through His world, while verses 7-11 give witness to God's glory through His Word. Note, too, that by connecting Psalms 18 and 19, we note that Psalm 18 is a Messianic Psalm and Psalm 19 is a Torah Psalm. We observed this same combination when we explored Psalms 1 and 2. Thus, we are entering through the second set of double doors as we make our way further into the Psalms.

Psalm 19 should also be viewed as a sequel to Psalm 8, since both of these Psalms combine to speak of God's creation, and then direct us from the creation to the Creator. As we explore Psalm 19 together, let's combine the emphasis upon God's world in verses 1-6 with God's Word in verses 7-11 as we seek to apply these changeless truths to the changing times in which we live.
