Pastor Jon MacDonald Acts Series

WHEN GOD'S WILL REQUIRES RISK

Acts 21:17-36

Paul has committed himself to bringing a financial gift from gentile believers scattered throughout Asia (1 Corinthians 16:1-3, Acts 24:17) to the church in Jerusalem, which was facing a famine. The reason he is doing this is two-fold: 1) to feed the people in the name of Jesus, and 2) to try to bridge a growing tension between Jewish and Gentile believers in the name of Jesus.

Luke (the Author of Acts) has twice stated that Paul is being led by the Holy Spirit to go to Jerusalem. In 19:21, "Paul resolved in the Spirit . . ." to go to Jerusalem. In 20:22, Paul is "constrained" by the Holy Spirit to go to Jerusalem, even though the ramifications of the decision would definitely result in imprisonment and affliction.

The Holy Spirit, then, is leading Paul not only to Jerusalem, but also to suffering (Acts 9:16). How do we go on when the suffering is certain? How do we go forward when my physical protection is uncertain?
