LIKE A SON OF MAN

Revelation 1:9-20

While living in Babylonian exile, the sixth century B.C. prophet, Daniel, experienced nighttime visions from the Lord. Daniel describes the coming Messiah with these words:

I saw in the night visions, and behold, with the clouds of heaven there came one like a son of man...

Daniel 7:13

The title *Son of Man* was a favored titled used by Jesus Christ to describe himself during his earthly ministry. For example, Mark informs us...
