PROMISE KEEPER Acts 13:13-25

Throughout the years, you will meet many people who are very familiar with the great stories of Scripture, but have not given their lives to Jesus Christ as their Savior and Lord. Such people need believers to come alongside and make the connections between the stories, explaining how each event in the Bible is part of God's master plan in which each part moves us along to the final fulfillment of God's plan, centered upon Jesus Christ.

As Paul and Barnabas leave Cyprus, we find them arriving at Perga, what is part of what is now known as Turkey. From there, they travel roughly 100 miles north and approximately 3600 feet up in order to arrive at Antioch in Pisidia. Entering the synagogue, Paul is given opportunity to address the crowd. Paul wisely connects the events in Jewish history, and shows how each is part of God's redemption story, culminating in Jesus Christ.
