Mother's Day

**AS I REMEMBER**  
*2 Timothy 1:3-7; 3:14-17*

On this Mother's Day, we will pause from our teachings in the book of Acts, and explore the spiritual influence of a mother and grandmother upon a young pastor named Timothy. The Apostle Paul had great insight regarding the way these women shaped Timothy's life. His mother's name was Eunice, and the grandmother was Lois. These women of faith instructed their offspring in the OT Scriptures, applying truth to life (2 Timothy 3:14).

In today's account, no mention is made of Timothy's father. In Acts 16:1, we are told that his father was a Greek, and his mother a devout Jewish Christian. It is likely that Paul first met Timothy in Lystra. When Paul was stoned at Lystra and presumed dead, disciples from Lystra gathered to meet Paul's physical needs. These disciples could very well include Lois, Eunice, and Timothy (Acts 14:19-20). On this Mother's Day, let's consider how a multigenerational ministry of faithfulness to God can be used to bring glory to God's name.
