Father's Day

THE LIFE COACH
Deuteronomy 6:1-25

In recent years, life coaches have acquired a recognizable presence in our culture. These individuals are types of wellness professionals, equipping people to lead fulfilling and meaningful lives. From a biblical point of view, we should consider fathers as life coaches, men who have a biblical worldview perspective to offer succeeding generations to honor God through faith in Christ, serving our Lord wholeheartedly.

The earthly father is designed to be a representative of the Heavenly Father in the family. His model should be God the Father and how he relates to his people. When speaking to the Israelites, Moses reminded the Israelites of how *the LORD your God carried you, as a man carries his son, all the way that you went until you came to this place* (Dt. 1:31). Moses also reminds us to *honor your father and your mother, as the LORD your God commanded you* (Dt. 5:16). On this Father's Day, we will pause to honor our life coaches, called to represent *Our Father in heaven* (Mt. 6:9).
