THE LORD And The Nation
Psalm 33

During this time period of Independence Day Weekend, we are given opportunity to pause and consider the relationship between our Sovereign God and this nation. David once wrote “For kingship belongs to the LORD, and *he rules over the nations* (Psalm 22:28). We are also instructed that it is God alone “who rules by his might forever, *whose eyes keep watch on the nations*—let not the rebellious exalt themselves” (Psalm 66:7).

As we reflect upon Psalm 33, we will note the connection between God the creator and God the ruler. The Declaration of Independence emphasizes this with the words “We hold these Truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are *endowed by their Creator* with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty, and the Pursuit of Happiness.” We will examine Psalm 33 today, and let these verses shape our thinking.
