#### NO GREATER BURDEN Acts 15:22-35

Unauthorized teachers have come into the early church and created confusion and anxiety, especially among the non-Jewish Christ-followers. These 'teachers' have been demanding that non-Jews (like you and me) become circumcised (15:1, 5) and continue to observe the ceremonial law of Moses as a condition of salvation. The Council of Jerusalem was convened to authoritatively settle the issue of "What is required in order to be included in the people of God?" The conclusion is clear! Salvation comes by faith alone (15:9) in the Messiah from God! Salvation is by grace alone (15:11)! And there is now no distinction between Jewish believers and Gentile believers (15:9), for together we make up one 'people of God!

While the Council of Jerusalem is a specific authoritative moment in church history, it teaches us much about communicating the good news of God's grace to our multicultural world today. Let's dig in!
