GOD'S INTERVENTIONS

Acts 27:39-28:6

In the midst of the Apostle Paul's 2250 mile journey to Rome, it appeared as though time was working against the 276 people aboard the ship. By November 11, most travel would cease on the open sea. The skies darkened for days on end, making it difficult to get one's bearings. The inevitability of storms required crews to search for safe harbors.

When God promised Paul in Acts 23:11 that he would testify on behalf of the Lord in Rome, no statement was made about the difficulties of the voyage, nor the severe trials the passengers would encounter. This serves as a fresh reminder that when we face trials, God's purposes might be unknown to us. *God does not owe us explanations, but we owe God our trust*. Let's ponder these thoughts, as we continue to reflect upon the voyage and shipwreck of the Apostle Paul.
