Date	Event/Theme	Details
Aug 26	<b>Mandatory Team Training</b>	All Awana staff to attend. There will be snacks!
Sept 2	Welcome to Awana!	Bonus points awarded to all clubbers who were registered by Wednesday, August 31st.
Sept 9	Red, White and Blue Night	<b>Come dressed wearing the colors of the US Flag</b>
Sept 16	Good Samaritan Night	<b>Bring non-perishable food item or toiletry item</b> for the church food pantry.
Sept 23	Favorite Sport Night	<b>Come dressed in your favorite sports team apparel or color(s).</b>
Sept 30	Hawaiian Night	<b>Come dressed in your favorite tropical outfit or Hawaiian shirt!</b>
Oct 7	80's Night	<b>Come to club wearing an outfit that celebrates the 1980's.</b> Ask your parent for tips! Bright colors, collars turned up or other look from the 1980's will work!
Oct 14	Team Spirit Night	Wear your Awana team color – you can even color your skin!
Oct 21	Operation Christmas Child (OCC) introduction <i>PLUS</i> <b>AWANA STORE</b>	OCC is a <b>worldwide children's project of Samaritan's Purse</b> that uses simple gift-filled shoeboxes containing school supplies, toys, toiletries and notes of encouragement to let hurting children know God loves them.
Oct 28	Operation Christmas Child begins	<b>Bring a school supply:</b> pens, pencils and sharpeners, crayons, markers, notebooks, paper, solar calculators, coloring and picture books, etc.
Nov 4	Operation Christmas Child continues	<b>Bring a non-liquid hygiene Items:</b> toothbrushes, bar soap, combs, or washcloths (liquid hygiene items like toothpaste cannot be sent)
Nov 11	Operation Christmas Child concludes	<b>Bring a small toy AND a personal letter or picture</b> to fit in a shoe box that a child your age and gender would enjoy. Toys can include cars, yo-yos, jump ropes, etc. OCC National Collection Week is November 16-23rd
Nov 18	Orange You Glad Jesus Loves You?	<b>Wear something ORANGE to club.</b>
Nov 25	<b>NO CLUB – THANKSGIVING</b>	Read Psalm 107:8-9 as a family and give thanks to the LORD.
Dec 2	Reason for the Season Night	<b>Come dressed in red &amp; green</b> and ready to sing as we celebrate the real reason behind Christmas!
Dec 9	Christmas Mitten Tree Night	<b>Bring a pair of gloves and mittens (hats OK too)</b> to decorate the tree for kids that need them. Watch the love grow and the tree come to life with colors of gloves, mittens and hats.
Dec 16	Ugly Sweater Night <i>PLUS</i> <b>AWANA STORE</b>	<b>Come to club wearing your ugliest sweater.</b> The clubber with the ugliest sweater gets 5 Awana shares.
Dec 23	Christmas Movie and PJ Night	<b>Come dressed wearing your comfy PJ's!</b> Come enjoy a fun relaxing evening watching a Christmas movie.
Dec 30	<b>NO CLUB</b>	<b>Merry Christmas! And a happy New Year!</b>
Jan 6	100% Dues Night	As the second half of the year begins, each clubber should bring his/her dues. <b>Extra 100 points will be awarded for having 100% of your dues paid by tonight.</b>
Jan 13	Small group spirit night <i>Announce Family Movie Night</i>	Come dressed in the theme/color that your small group will decide upon. The group with the best theme will receive a 5 share per clubber.
Jan 20	A Soup-er Night	January is National Soup Month. <b>Bring a can of soup or a box of crackers</b> that will be donated to our food pantry.

Jan 27	Crazy Hair Night	<b>Come to club in your craziest, wackiest or funniest hairstyle</b>

Feb 3	Layer Night	Come dressed in as many layers as possible! Top kids in each club get 5 Awana shares
