## Get Ready for Awana!

Are you longing to see the lives of children changed? If so, let us invite you to the right place: Awana Youth Clubs! We're just five weeks away from a brand new year of reaching students with the Good News of Jesus Christ and training them to know, love, and serve Him. Each 90-minute encounter combines learning with fun to create an atmosphere of irresistible excitement for churched and un-churched kids alike. Club is divided into three segments:

- Age-appropriate games on the Awana game circle
- Small group interaction and completion of Bible-based lessons
- Bible teaching, worship, award presentations, and the Gospel message

Cubbies provides foundational teaching for potty-trained preschoolers, ages 3 (by 9/1/18) and 4. Games, puppets, crafts, awards and other activities create a lively weekly experience where fun and learning go hand-in-hand.

**Truth and Training (T&T)** will continue to lead students in grades 3-6 through a deeper dive into the Bible. This year, they will spend time learning how to be Agents of Grace by understanding the attributes of God, the importance of biblical theology, and the seven "I AM" statements of Jesus Christ from the Gospel of John.

about various Bible studies, volunteer opportunities, and connection points.



Registration forms will be mailed the first week of August to last year's clubbers. Forms should be updated and returned to the church office by August 31. Registration will be held in the Welcome Center prior to 2nd and 3rd services on August 19, 26 and September 2. Registration will also be available online at www.e-free-family.com or can be done weekdays in the church office. (Online registrants will need to see the Awana Secretary to sign a medical release.)

## Meet an Addition to our Missions Family!

Meet Abraham and Maria Mudidi, serving Africa with ReachGlobal/ReachAfrica! Abraham came from a Protestant Christian background and Maria came from a Catholic background, but it wasn't until later that both Abraham and Maria surrendered their lives to Christ and desired to grow as His disciples.

For 11 years, Abraham resisted God's call to be a pastor. But finally, he decided to go to seminary and has since served as a University Chaplain, church planter, evangelist, pastor, and teacher, before taking on his current role as a missionary in 2014.

Abraham leads and oversees the multiplication church planting French-speaking efforts of the ReachAfrica teams. He also does translation (English to French) of training materials and interpreting for visitors coming to do training in Congo. Abraham & Maria are also involved in adoption and foster care.
