Text-to-Give Now an Option!

Beginning December 1, you will be able to give your tithes and offerings via text (TTG) if you wish. If you are already an online giver, just log in, add your cell num-



ber to update your profile, and text your desired donation to 920.523.4113.

If you do not presently give online, it's very simple to set up an account. Go to the church website home page (www.e-free-family.com), click on Menu, click on Giving, then Online, and follow the instructions. Then, all you need to do is text the dollar amount of your donation to 920.523.4113 any time you wish

to give to church. There is no banking fee for this service. If you have any questions, please contact Ann Tuneberg in the church office.

Winter Weather Procedures

Before the first snowfall, the church reviews and puts into practice its Winter Weather Procedures – when to plow/blow snow, how frequently to salt, when to cancel activities, and how to notify the congregation and community of schedule changes.

Decisions that affect Sunday morning services will be made at 6am, while decisions about Sunday and Wednesday evenings will be made by 3:30pm. Weekday activity changes will be announced as soon as possible in advance.

All weather-related changes will be announced and posted shortly after the decision is made on: WHBL 1330AM radio/website, WTMJ Channel 4, 620TMJ radio/website, and WITI Channel 6 (Fox). Additionally, changes will be posted on the home page of the church website (www.e-free-family.com). Staff will also contact their respective ministry leaders who will then notify their affected volunteers.

Year-End Giving

Many people like to bless the church in extra ways during the holiday season; others like to take advantage of tax deductions for additional charitable giving. No matter which, if you'd like to give a special gift at calendar year-end, here are some things the IRS requires regarding 2017 year-end giving:

- Mailed gifts must be postmarked by Saturday, 12/30; the Sheboygan Post Office will be open until 5pm.
- Tithes and offerings can be given in the offering plate on Sunday morning, 12/31. Gifts dropped in the lock boxes at the backs of the Sanctuary and MPR will count for this purpose.
- Gifts may be physically brought to the office up to 12pm noon on Sunday, 12/31.
- Online giving, via any method, can be transacted through 11:59pm on Sunday, 12/31. Be sure to begin the process several minutes ahead of time.

For tax purposes, year-end giving letters will be mailed late January.
