

Will You Stand Up for Life? 🤇

The right to life is the most basic human right. An aborted baby will never be able to make his/her own choices—to live, love, and be happy—because someone else was inconvenienced, uncertain, pressured, afraid, or lacked courage to give them that chance.

40 Days for Life is an internationally coordinated 40-day campaign that aims to end abortion locally through prayer and fasting, community outreach, and a peaceful prayer vigil in front of abortion businesses. It involves us outside our local abortion facilities, invoking God to transform hearts and minds to end abortion in our cities, our country, and our world.

The spring 40 Days for Life campaign will be from February 17-March 28. Over 500 cities around the world will be participating. In Sheboygan during this time, the prayer campaign will be daily from 7am-7pm on the sidewalk outside of Planned Parenthood at 909 S. Taylor Drive/New Jersey Avenue.

A kick-off rally will be held on Sunday, February 14 at 1pm at the vigil site. Sue Thayer, Director of Outreach for 40 Days of Life, will be guest speaker. Sue is from Iowa and was formerly a Planned Parenthood manager there. She later led a 40 Days for Life campaign outside her former workplace which resulted in its shutting down.

On Friday, April 9, our church will host the live simulcast of Show Hope's *Hope for the Journey* conference.


The aim of this one-day event is to shepherd parents and caregivers to a deeper understanding of their children's needs, particularly those with children who've experienced adoption and/or foster care.

Hope for the Journey teaches the TBRI (Trust-Based Relational Intervention) model for caring for children, including a brand-new learning module—TBRI and the Gospel.

The conference will also highlight adult adopt-

ee voices and experiences, offering participants greater insight to the often complex needs of children impacted by adoption or foster care.

Cost will be \$10/person. Registration and additional conference details will be forthcoming.
