Master Plan — Next Steps

On January 21, the Deacon Board voted to approve the next step in the Master Plan – asbestos abatement of the west property (former Quasius buildings), to be undertaken by SAFE, Inc. of Sturtevant. Once that company has notified the Wisconsin DNR, and the DNR has had its mandatory 2-week inspection period, abatement (careful removal of all asbestos-containing material) can begin. That process is expected to begin the 2nd week of February and take 3 weeks. Upon completion, demolition of the remaining building components will begin.

Listen for Sunday morning updates and look for announcements in the weekly bulletin. A sequence timeline will also be posted on the church website soon.

Overview of Mid-Year Finances

Thank you for your faithful giving to the Sheboygan eFree body of Christ. We know that, for many, consistent giving has been the result of personal sacrifice. We want to be transparent about how funds are used, and what the needs of our church are.

At the midpoint of our fiscal year (December 31), the Finance Committee had projected giving at \$596,000, anticipating that, in a local economy with rising incomes, our tithes would naturally increase. However, \$564,625 was given (less than 1% above last year), resulting in a \$31,400 shortfall. We were blessed that midyear expenses were less than anticipated: \$599,765 projected vs. \$547,174 actual. We still have a surplus, though it has now dropped to \$21,200.


God has given our leadership a vision for a facility that will allow our ministries and programs to flourish, in order to meet both the needs of our congregation and reach our city, country and continents for Him. That vision, as well as funds for daily operation, is reflected in our current budget. As we trust Him to provide the funds needed to realize the vision, let's ask Him how He desires to use us – our abilities, our time, our finances – in making that vision a reality.
