Welcome Back to Children's Ministry!

We are so excited to be able to restart our Sunday morning children's ministry programing! We can not wait to spend time with your kids! Sunday, June 28th is our restart target date for first and second service children's ministry. This will include Babies and Toddlers through 6th grade (student ministries also plans to start the same week). There are some minor adjustments though. Temporarily, the 4's & 5's and Kindergarten classes will be combined in the 4's and 5's classroom during second service. In the elementary school, some grade groups may be combined or split based on the week's needs, but all elementary kids will still meet in their regular classrooms.

We are doing our part to provide a clean and healthy environment, though it is a team effort! Some things you as parents can do to help:

- Please, if you child shows any symptoms of illness, keep them home. We will look forward to seeing them when they are well!
- If possible, have only one parent (preferably the same parent) drop off and pick up your child on Sunday mornings. This will help limit foot traffic and the number of people gathered at classroom entrances and exits before and after the service.
- Please have your child wash their hands before and after they attend class.
