

Easy Ways to Give when You're Away

If you desire to obediently give to God through His church while on vacation or away from home this summer, there are several easy ways to do that:

- ACH a process where you ask the church to set up an automatic contribution (weekly, bi-monthly or monthly) directly from your checking or savings account
- Online you create an account through the church's website and then indicate the dollar amount that should be moved from your financial institution to the church's on a date of your request
- Text-to-Give after you create an account through the church's website, you simply text the church's designated account number what amount and when you'd like to give
- Automatic Bill Payment you arrange with your financial institution to transfer money on the predetermined date you choose on a recurring basis.

Since online giving became an option six years ago, more than 10% of the church's annual income is received using this secured method.

Fund Name is Changed

With the overwhelming affirmation of the Master Plan at the May Body Life Update, we have officially renamed our Land/Building Fund – it is now the Master Plan Fund.

The Land/Building Fund has always been designated for such a time as this—to be directed toward a visionary church expansion. Any donations made to the Land/Building Fund (such as on the offering envelopes) will automatically become part of the Master Plan.
