National Day of Prayer


The National Day of Prayer exists with the longing and intent for individuals,

Spring BLU Amidst Social Distancing

At the time of writing this article, the Wisconsin *Safer at Home* mandate had been extended until May 26. Because of that, we will need to be creative in how, and when, we hold our Spring Body Life Update. Leadership is considering a two-part format:

- ▶ Recording the presentations of the Senior Pastor, Elder Chairman, Deacon Chairman, and Treasurer, and airing them via our social media accounts
- Providing members an opportunity to vote on the budget onsite over a multi-week time period



Both these points are in the development stages. Leadership wants to provide sufficient information to keep the congregation updated while protecting the confidentiality of church information and the privacy of its members. More details will be shared via the Sunday bulletin and pulpit announcements, as well as through a mass mailing to the church fellowship.



Girls' Bible Study Starting

O Lord, how long shall I cry for help, and you will not hear? (Habakkuk 1:2a, ESV)

Have you ever asked this question? Life is filled with questions. But, not all questions have answers wrapped and neatly tied. Habakkuk was troubled and brought his concerns directly to God. After receiving God's answers, he responded with a prayer of faith. Habakkuk's example is one that encourages us as we struggle to move from doubt to faith and from worry to worship.
