Do you know a child who can't tell you his address or phone number because his family moves *that* frequently? *Then you know a child from hard places*.

Do you know a youngster who was or currently is in foster care? Then you know a child from hard places.

Empowered To Connect, together with Show Hope and The Karyn Purvis Institute of Child Development at Texas Christian University, will present a two-day conference designed to help adoptive and foster parents, ministry leaders, and

professionals better understand how to connect with *children from hard places* in order to help them heal and become all that God desires for them to be. The conference features Daren Jones, Dr. Casey Call, Sarah Mercado, Dan and Terri Coley, and Ryan and Kayla North.



Our church will host a live simulcast from 9am to 5pm on April 13 and 14 at a cost of \$20 per person. It will feature Trust-Based

Relational Intervention® methods developed by Dr. Karyn Purvis and Dr. David Cross. This year's conference will feature a revised program and new material for those who have attended multiple years.

Children from hard places have changes in their bodies, brains, behaviors, and belief systems. While a variety of parenting strategies may be successful in typical circumstances, children from hard places need care-giving that meets their unique needs and addresses the whole child. Trust-Based Relational Intervention® is a holistic, attachment-based and trauma-informed intervention that is designed to meet the complex needs of vulnerable children. Although TBRI® was designed for children who have experienced some type of abuse, neglect and/or trauma, it has proven to be effective with all children.

Equip classes are Sunday morning electives designed to build up the body of Christ (Ephesians 4:11-16). Our next session starts March 4! Choose from the topics below and register in the church office or on the church website under Connect/Adults/Equip.

- This We Believe*—Learn the history of our congregation and the basic tenets that define our church. This class is also a church membership requirement. Meets at 9:30am. *starts February 25
- Bring It To Life—Discuss the Sunday sermon and learn to apply it better to your everyday life. Meets at 9:30am.
- *Transformed*—When you trust Jesus as Savior and Lord, "everything changes". Look at 4 key changes in every Christian's life (Romans 12:1-2). Meets at 9:30am.
- The Lord's Prayer—"The Lord's Prayer as a Lens for Life." Meets at 9:30am.
- Intercession 101 Missions Edition—Join us as we pray for our supported missionaries. Meets at 9:30am.
- When No One Is Looking—Distinctive personal integrity in an anything-goes world. Meets at 11am.
