

GOAL: Retire Debt, Save for Expansion

As the Master Plan moves closer to reality, the Finance Committee desires to pay off the mortgage of \$446,729, incurred from the purchase of the former



Quasius building. Ideally, paying off the debt before we begin major construction will allow us to save more, and borrow less, for the campus expansion.

Gifts above the tithe can be targeted to help reduce the current debt. Note that Solomon's Temple was built exclusively with gifts above the tithe. If God is

leading you to help in this effort, you can give in several ways:

- 1. Write "Debt Reduction" on the bottom line of your offering envelope or on the memo line of your check
- 2. Use a bank check (ACH) and specify the purpose of the gift
- 3.Go to the church website, click Online Giving, and choose the Debt Reduction icon
- 4. Use bill-pay to electronically give towards debt reduction

We are in awe of how God works as we respond to His faithfulness.

Have you visited our church website lately? Recently, the site has been redesigned in an effort to better communicate information about our church to both attendees and those seeking a church home.


