#### **GET INVOLVED**

At our recent Missions Conference, we heard an update about "Tabitha Centers" in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC). Tabitha Centers train young women in the Scriptures and teach them a living skill (like sewing or cosmetology) so they can support themselves for life. Our missionaries are hopeful to open up to 1,000 Tabitha Centers throughout the capital city of the DRC, Kinshasa, in the next several years. To date they have opened over 120 Tabitha Centers. Before these young ladies can enter the Tabitha Center program, they must be able to read and write. That's where we come in! There is a sponsorship program through "Global Fingerprints" whereby we can sponsor young ladies (for 2-3 years for about \$35 per month) who are learning to read and write so that they are prepared for success in the Tabitha Centers.
