### **THE HAND THAT FASHIONED US**

*Job 10:8-12*

It was on January 22, 1973, when the Supreme Court of the United States announced its decision regarding abortion in the case of *Roe v. Wade*. The decision, made by a 7-2 majority, overturned laws restricting or prohibiting abortion in all states across the nation. The majority claimed to have found this right in the 14th Amendment to the Constitution, arguing for a *right to privacy* in the *due process* portion of the amendment.

On December 1, 2021, the Supreme Court heard oral arguments in the case of *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization*. In light of this recent case, the possibility exists that *Roe v. Wade* be either overturned or else modified and restricted in its application. The decision is expected to be announced later this year. As we do on a yearly basis, we are pausing on this Sanctity of Human Life Weekend, and exploring how to apply biblical principles that promote a culture of life.
